

Keys For a Successful ChemE Jeopardy Team

- Practice! The clues/responses given on the ChemE Jeopardy website (<https://www.aiche.org/community/awards/cheme-jeopardy-competition>) can be used.
- Factile software (<https://www.playfactile.com>) can be used to run the practice games. A “Business Pro” account is needed to provide the necessary. There is a monthly fee (\$9.50 USD) associated with a Business Pro account. Details about constructing the game boards and running a game with Factile can be found in the ChemE Jeopardy Rules and Instructions document found on the ChemE Jeopardy website.
- Use the 12 player buzzer systems (see <https://buzzersystems.com/product/traditional-buzzer-system/>) for your practices. This is the buzzer system that is used in the regional and national competitions. This system currently costs \$489.
- A key to success is working as a team. Specifically, it is recommended that teams practice talking among themselves when the emcee is reading the clue (must stop talking at time that somebody on the team buzzes in).
