ATOMICALLY PRECISE MANUFACTURING

Atomically Precise Manufacturing (APM) refers to newly emerging capabilities to produce materials and devices that are virtually defect-free. Atomically precise products will provide game-changing advances in energy applications and beyond. The presentation will describe the Dept. of Energy Advanced Manufacturing Office programming in this technology space, and the projects that are being funded. Approaches include new methods for atomically precise catalysts, self-assembly of engineered molecular building blocks, positional assembly using scanning probe microscopes, and positional assembly using molecular machine systems. The qualitative differences between APM and conventional technologies (such as atomic layer deposition and single crystal growth, which are not atomically precise) will be discussed.

Dr. David Forrest is a Technology Manager in the Department of Energy's Advanced Manufacturing Office (AMO), where he focuses on Atomically Precise Manufacturing, high performance materials, and advanced material processes. He also manages the High Performance Computing for Manufacturing program at AMO as well as projects in AMO's SBIR-STTR Program. Dr. Forrest earned his doctorate degree in materials engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1993. He is a Fellow of ASM International.

GET THE MOST OUT OF THE DISCUSSIONS ON AICHE'S ENGAGE

AIChE hosts a platform called Engage that connects AIChE members with each other and their chemical engineering communities. One of the features of this platform is the discussions, the largest of which is Discussion Central.

All members of AIChE can post to
Discussion Central and anybody with an
Internet connection can view Discussion
Central posts. This discussion group has some
very lively and interesting threads.

In July, for example, there was an informative thread about the history and future of ethanol in gasoline in the US.

As a Virtual Local Section member, you are also allowed to view and post to the discussion community labeled "Virtual Local Section Central". The posts on this site focus on items of interest to the section.

To access Discussion Central you must log onto www.aiche.org. There is a banner across the top of the page with a drop down menu labeled "AIChE Sites" located to the left of the banner. Click on the drop-down arrow and select Engage, which is in the top row. Select the drop-down menu for Discussions and select Discussion Central.

To access the Virtual Local Section
Central site, you must log into the Engage web
page. Once you are logged in, click the word
"Discussions" in the top role. Then click on "My
Discussion Groups" in the drop menu to access
a list of the discussion groups located within
the Engage database. Using the drop-down
menus listed below the "My Discussion Group"
banner, you can obtain a list of groups you can
join. Then click on the title for each discussion
group you wish to follow and contribute
comments.

Scroll down the list until you reach the Virtual Local Section discussion group. Then click it to access our discussions.

When you log into Discussion Central for the first time, you can select your email delivery preferences for the discussion digests by discussion group. Once you select one of the discussion groups, there is a settings button with a gear icon next to the name of the discussion. One of the options in settings is email notifications. Enter your email and select one of the following options: daily digest, no digest, or real-time notifications. Once you confirm your selection, you will receive the Digital Digest as selected.

Selecting the "Daily Digest" option sends a daily summary of active discussions to your inbox every day there is an addition to the ongoing discussions in your communities.

With these instructions, add your voice to the discussions on AIChE's Engage platform.
