

Permission to Publish

Documentation of authors' Permission to Publish is granted through the process of uploading papers to Confex. In the event that someone uploads on behalf of the author, an extra step is required to document their agreement that AIChE and EPC may publish their papers and presentations. In all cases, author retains copyright.

In the case where the author does not personally upload to Confex, the principal author must affirm their permission to publish via an email to (1) the Session Chair, (2) AIChE (programming@aiiche.org), and (3) EPC Knowledge Management (ethyleneproducerscommittee@gmail.com). The affirmation email must contain agreement with the following:

By sending your paper/presentation, you will be granting permission (please see the permissions policy as it exists in AIChE's Confex system below) for the paper and slides to be included on AIChE's password-protected proceedings website as well as EPC's subscription based online library.

By uploading an extended abstract or slides you are granting AIChE permission for itself and its designated agents to reproduce, sell, or distribute your paper. Copyright to this paper is retained by the author (s) and/or employer (s), from whom permission to reproduce must be obtained by any other party. Please note that the rights to papers authored by employees or contractors of the U.S. government may differ.
