<u>August 13 Mtg.</u>

I. Reading of the Anti-Trust Statement

II. Five Minutes on Safety:

Discussed recent rains, and some people have discovered that their windshield wiper blades are damaged from the extreme summer temps & do not clean well. - Fundamentals Session Paper ideas

Bob K reviewed Jack's spreadsheet on Fundamentals papers. We made some progress on locating papers. Vacations in Europe slowed down many responses. Updated spreadsheet attached.

- Possible Joint sessions with other subcommittees

<u>Feedstock Flexability</u> – Alain Chepda & Thomas Emmert have agreed to lead up the session of feed flexibility. Discussed that operating companies will possibly be reluctant to reveal their feedstock flex limits. Could need to rely on technology companies, or consultants for papers. Possible general topic areas:

- 1. Furnace strategies (feeding Ethane vs. Naphtha to a furnace)
- 2. Light feeds to quench
- 3. Gas Separation issues
- 4. General pitfalls

MACT Session - Strategy to comply, PM2.5 - how to validate, firing, decoking

<u>Mega Projects</u> – Sanjeev submitted a draft for the Mega Project session, as follows. "Innovations in managing capital cost of Ethylene based Petrochemical Investments

The changing energy market dynamics can have significant impact on the economics of new investments, even in a cost advantaged feedstock scenario, as the cost of production curve flattens. Owners are under pressure from financial institutions and/or shareholders to improve the capital costs and efficiency. This poses a challenge and an opportunity for engineering and construction businesses to come up with design, procurement and construction approaches that deliver these mega projects cost efficiently and meeting the business objectives. Ethylene Producers Committee (EPC) of North America is planning to sponsor a session during 2016 conference in Houston (as a part AIChE's Spring Meeting from April 10 – 14, 2016). This session will invite industry leaders to participate in panel

discussions to share their thoughts and ideas for delivering these facilities cost efficiently. The session will be kicked-off with one or two presentations providing contextual background and to stimulate discussion."

Sanjeev has begun discussions with various contacts for possibly papers, and/or short topics that companies would be willing to discuss. This past 2015 session on "Technology Trends" went well with a few lead-in papers followed by some seeded questions. Linde has committed to one paper? Fluor paper maybe? He would like to get some operating companies to discuss ~ 5 minutes on any topic related to mega projects issues.

Greg will check with Separations Section for thoughts on a joint session, as well as discussing with Environmental committee in AIChE on MACT related session
