Our presenter is my boss for the last 15+ years, Scott Brotherton of Ortec, Inc. When I came through Clemson 44 years ago, we heard all about DuPont, Dow, Union Carbide, Celanese and the other heavyweights of the chemical manufacturing world. I thought I had interesting career, then I joined Ortec. Since then, it's been fascinating and challenging like nothing I'd ever experienced. I've worked on and implemented more technologies and unit operations in the last 15 years than I did in the first 29.

Scott Brotherton is a 1989 graduate of Clemson's chemical engineering program. He started out as a new graduate working for Columbia Nitrogen in Augusta, GA. He later worked for Noramco in Athens, Georgia before returning to Ortec, Inc.

He designed, built, and operated Ortec's first GMP facility in Piedmont, SC and has since risen to be Sr. VP of Ortec's Life Sciences Division.

Scott will be presenting on The Ortec, Inc. Story. Ortec, Inc. was founded by Dr, Larry Brotherton in 1980 and it has grown steadily over the last 43 years and now has 4 plant sites, including one in Europe. It's truly one of the great success stories, not just in the tolling world, but in US industry in general. We forget that all the big names in industry started out as 1-3 people with a vision and a drive for success.
