If It Isn't Secure, It Isn't Safe

Tim Gale March 12, 2019

The convergence of Information Technology (IT) and Operations Technology (OT) platforms has exposed modern industrial control systems to increased risk. Cyber threats have the potential to affect multiple layers of protection, including basic process control, process alarms and safety instrumented systems. The OT environment faces unique challenges when attempting to secure its systems. This presentation will explore the connection between cybersecurity and process safety, look at some of the day to day threats the process industry faces and approaches to harden the systems that control and protect our facilities.

Tim Gale, an Industrial Cybersecurity Senior Principal Specialist, has more than 25 years' experience in Cybersecurity, Process Safety and Process Control in the Oil & Gas, Specialty Chemical, Pulp and Paper, Food & Beverage, Pharmaceutical and Mining industries.
