Mixing Technology Fundamentals Michelle Laud & Steven Barnak (Philadelphia Mixing Solutions) September 10, 2019

Mixers are ubiquitous in chemical plants, and often taken for granted. Do you know the best mixer design for your application, or how its design affects the performance of your process?

New product processes present challenges in heat transfer, mass transfer, and other challenging process kinetics requiring more sophistication than the repurposed equipment being used to produce them. Philadelphia Mixing Solutions has a track record in modelling, designing and deploying new mixing solutions, in a wide variety of demanding applications.

The presentation will explore the principle duties of a mixer: blending/heat transfer, solids suspension, and dispersion. It will be shown how mechanical component design (shafts, seals, couplings) and impeller design (radial, axial, mixed, low level) are used to fulfill the principle duties. Guidelines will then be given for sizing and scale-up of mixing in new product processes.
