On Tuesday April 13th Sen Li of Eastman Chemical Company spoke about "Effective tools to enhance consistency and transparency of quality measurement in the manufacturing industry". Sen spoke about the growing demand for consistent and transparent quality testing and assurance. In the manufacturing industry, it has become more challenging to deliver on these demands due to business globalization and product diversification. A few of the tools Sen shared included a round robin study, behavior-based quality (BBQ) and a Task Quality Audit (TQA). Sen's presentation demonstrated how these tools have been used at Eastman Chemical Company in daily operations and what quality assurance improvements have henceforth been generated.
