February Section Meeting: Applications of Data Science in Chemical Engineering

Dr. David A. C. Beck is a Research Associate Professor of Chemical Engineering at the University of Washington (UW), where he and his research group investigate varied applications of bioinformatics and computational biochemistry, including biogeochemical cycling, the human microbiome, and the natural and built environments. Professor Beck is additionally the Director of Research - Life Sciences at the eScience Institute, an Adjunct Research Associate Professor in UW's Department of Occupational Environmental & Sciences, and the Associate Director of the NRT Data Intensive Research Enabling Clean Tech. A molecular data scientist by training, Professor Beck is a strong data science advocate in the arts, engineering, humanities, and sciences.
