About Teeny Foods

Teeny Foods began as Middle East Bakeries, Inc., by Sam & Minerva Teeny, in the Montavilla district of Portland in 1964 as a bakery making pocket bread from a recipe Minerva brought with her from Lebanon. This makes it the oldest commercial pocket bread and flat bread manufacturer in the U.S. Today, Teeny Foods produces over 200 varieties of pizza crusts, along with filled breadsticks, breadsticks, and of course flat bread & pocket bread. The name of the company was changed to Teeny Foods Corp. in 1989 by Sam & Minerva’s family, as a way to honor them upon Sam’s retirement.
