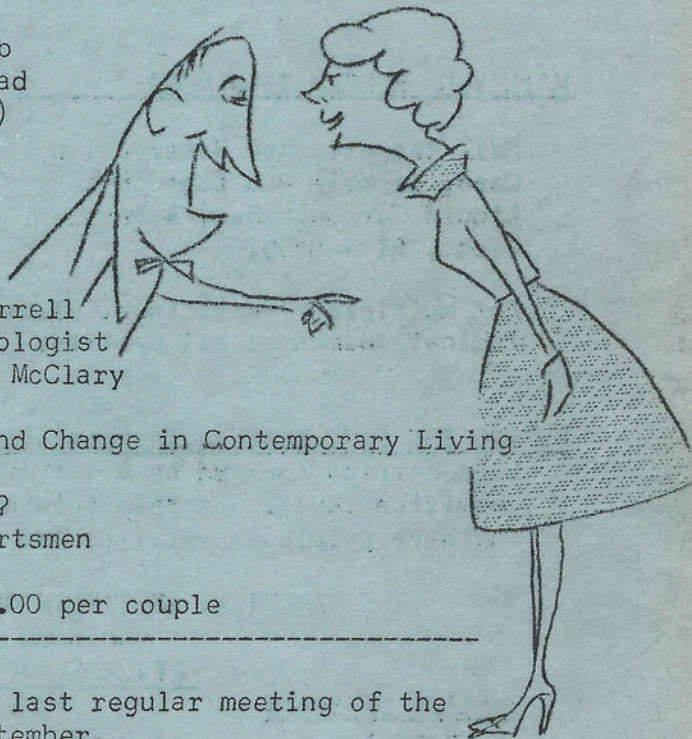

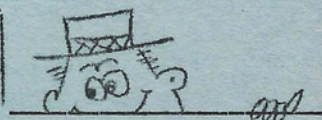
ABOUT THE SPEAKER:
