

ABOUT THE SPEAKER:

Jerry Proctor graduated from Texas A & M in 1955. He received his Masters and Doctors degrees from Cornell University in 1958 and 1960, respectively. In his present position as head of the Nutrition Laboratory for National Dairy Products, he has the responsibility of directing the nutritional studies of the Kraft Foods Company, which is owned by National Dairy.

Dr. Proctor's areas of research include: Antibiotic response in animals, nutritional muscular dystrophy, and deficiency diseases. He is a member of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Society of Animal Science, The American Association of Vitamin Chemists and the Nutrition Society of Great Britain and Ireland.

In his talk, "What You Eat Becomes You", Dr. Proctor will cover the relationship of the food we eat to our general health and appearance.
