Apply for WIC Awards

WIC has two award categories that will be presented at the Annual Meeting in Phoenix, AZ.: the Travel Award and Mentorship Excellence Award.

The WIC Travel Award supports travel to the Annual Meeting for female graduate students, postdocs, early career individuals, and young professionals (<35 years old). This award provides \$800 per awardee toward registration, travel, and hotel costs. Nominations are due Sept. 15.

The Mentorship Excellence Award recognizes women who have contributed to the development of the next generation of chemical engineers through outstanding mentoring. This year, WIC Awards Chair Soumya Srivastava expanded the Mentorship Excellence Award to include three categories: industry/national labs, academic professors, and graduate students/postdocs.
