


Creating/Updating Your AIChE Profile

Before you begin, please be sure to confirm you have an existing account profile

If you have created a profile in the past or think you may have, STOP and call Customer Service at 1-800-242-4363 Monday – Friday 9am – 5pm EST. Creating a second profile can result in problems going forward.

Existing Users

If you know your login/password, log in here and proceed to your profile. The "Professional" section will need to be updated with your Wacker information (company will autofill once you begin typing). Choose the first "Wacker Chemical Corp" from the listed options below where you typed in order to get the rate for Wacker employees. PLEASE CHOOSE THIS ONE EVEN IF THIS IS NOT THE LOCATION YOU ARE EMPLOYED AT.




New Users

If you're a new user, select sign in and create a guest account.




Click one of two links to create a guest account.


***Just typing the name "Wacker Chemical" WILL NOT let you obtain the courses free of charge. YOU MUST select the first/ top company on the drop down list!



Accessing a Course


Once your account is set up, you are ready to access eligible courses from this program. When you are ready to begin a course, go to the Wacker Course Offerings page for easy access to the course list and other resources.

After selecting a course, you will see pricing on the right side of the screen. YOU MUST click CHECKOUT to proceed to checkout to get the course at \$0.00.




NOTE: All courses on the offerings page are free for Wacker employees. If your account is not recognizing you as such, please contact customerservice@aiche.org.

After completing the checkout process, your course will now show in your "My Purchases" section of the Academy website. You can also return to the course and click "Access Course"



If you select "My Purchases", your screen will refresh to a webpage that will contain a list of all the content you are able to access. Simply click on your course and you will be brought to your current / recent training. After selecting the course, you will be able to take each module.




NOTE: You may need to log-in again after selecting a course if you have cleared your cache. Login again to be taken to your current training.
